Answers:

1. Satan stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.
2. Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour

4. God was displeased with this thing, therefore He smote Israel.
5. David said unto God, I have sinned greatly, because I have done this thing: but now, I beseech thee, do away the iniquity of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly.
6. God sent word by Gad to choose from three things: Either three years' famine, or three months while that the sword of David's enemies overtakehim, or else three days the sword of the LORD, even the pestilence, in the land, and the angel of the LORD destroying throughout all the coasts of Israel.
7. David saw the angel of the LORD stand between the earth and the heaven, having a drawn sword in his hand stretched out over Jerusalem; go and set up an altar unto the LORD in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.
8. God answered by fire upon the altar of burnt offering and David saw that the Lord commanded the angel, and he put up his sword again into the sheath thereof.
9. This is the house of the LORD God, and this is the altar of the burnt offering for Israel.
10. David prepared abundantly for the house of the Lord; David told Solomon to prosper and build the house of the Lord as God said for him to do.
11. Solomon sat on the throne instead of David and all of Israel obeyed him.
12. The Lord magnified Solomon exceedingly in the sight of all Israel, and bestowed upon him royal majesty as had not been on any king before him in Israel.
