Answers:

1. Solomon strengthened in his kingdom, and the LORD his God *was* with him, and magnified him exceedingly; Gibeon to sacrifice

2. the LORD give you wisdom and understanding, and give you charge concerning Israel, that you keep the law of the LORD your God, and then you will prosper, if you take heed to fulfill the statutes and judgments which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: be strong, and of good courage, dread not, nor be dismayed

3. Wisdom and knowledge *is* granted to you; and I will give thee riches, and wealth, and honor, such as none of the kings have had before you, neither shall there any after you have the like

4. the king made silver and gold at Jerusalem as plenteous as stones, and cedar trees made he as the sycamore trees in abundance

5. Solomon determined to build an house for the name of the LORD, and an house for his kingdom; began to build the house of the LORD at Jerusalem in mount Moriah

6. all the work that Solomon made for the house of the LORD was finished and Solomon brought in all the things that David his father had dedicated, and the silver, and the gold, and all the instruments, put he among the treasures of the house of God; while they sang and played their instruments, a cloud came – for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God

7. fire came down from heaven, and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the glory of the LORD filled the house

8. LORD appeared to Solomon by night, and said unto him, I have heard thy prayer, and have chosen this place to myself, when troubles may come God promised “If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land”

9. God would hear the prayers in that house and God chose and sanctified this house, that my name may be there forever: and God’s eyes and heart shall be there perpetually

10. God would cast the people out of His sight, and will make the Temple to be a proverb and a byword among all nations.

11. She believed not their words, until she went, and her eyes saw it all and, behold, the one half of the greatness of Solomon’s wisdom was not told to her for Solomon exceeded the fame that she heard; God

12. king Solomon passed all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom

13. all the kings of the earth sought the presence of Solomon, to hear his wisdom, that God had put in his heart
