Answers:

1. a vision concerning Judah and Jerusalem;
2. Woe is me! for I am undone because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?; Here am I, send me;
3. Go and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost, teaching them to observe everything Jesus has commanded; answers will vary (hopefully “Yes!”);
4. Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah, kings of Judah; mainly Judah;
5. he said in his heart, “I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High”; he will be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit; no;
6. Philip; a man of Ethiopia, an eunuch of great authority under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, who had the charge of all her treasure, and had come to Jerusalem for to worship; Go near, and join himself to that chariot; the prophet Esaias (Isaiah); do you understand what you are reading?; How can I unless someone guide me?; yes;
