Answers:

1. every one mocked Jeremiah; “But his word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not stay”; no;

2. to stop prophesying in the name of the LORD, because they wanted to kill Jeremiah;

3. told them to amend their ways and their doings, and obey the voice of the LORD and the LORD would not do the evil that he hath pronounced against you, but told them “I am in your hand: do with me as seemeth good and meet unto you”; Jeremiah knew they wanted to kill him;

4. neither King Zedekiah, nor his servants, nor the people of the land, did listen to the words of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah;

5. 1) Jeremiah was sick to his heart 2) Jeremiah was put in the stocks 3) Jeremiah was allowed to suffer in prison 4) they smote Jeremiah and put him in prison 5) Jeremiah was in a dungeon in the mire;

6. Jeremiah abode in the court of the prison until the day that Jerusalem was taken;

7. he king of Babylon slew the sons of Zedekiah before his eyes, also the king of Babylon slew all the nobles of Judah, he put out Zedekiah's eyes, bound him in chains, carried him to Babylon, and put him in prison till the day of his death;

8. the pillars of brass, the bases, the brasen sea in the house of the LORD, the Chaldeans brake, and carried all the brass of them to Babylon, and the caldrons, the shovels, the snuffers, the bowls, the spoons, and all the vessels of brass wherewith they ministered, they took to Babylon, and the basons, the firepans, the bowls, the caldrons, the candlesticks, the spoons, the cups; all that were gold, and of silver they took; And they burned the house of the Lord (the Temple);

9. After seventy years, they would call unto God, He will listen, they will seek after Him and be found of Him when they searched with all of their heart, then God would turn away their captivity, gather them and let them go home
