Answers:

1. fifth day of the month, the fifth year of king Jehoiachin's captivity, in the land of the Chaldeans by the river Chebar;

2. for all the house of Israel are impudent and hardhearted; the children of the people in captivity;

3. a watchman unto the house of Israel; warning from God;

4. glory of the God of Israel from the Temple; up from the midst of the city, and stood upon the mountain which is on the east side of the city

5. “to know that I am the LORD”; they had not walked God’s statutes, neither executed His judgments, but had done after the manners of the heathen that were round about them;

6. God promised to give them one heart, and He would put a new spirit within them; and He would take the stony heart out of their flesh, and would give them an heart of flesh; “That they may walk in my statutes, and keep mine ordinances, and do them: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God”

7. each person is accountable to God for their own life – if one chooses to remain a sinner, not humbling the heart before God, that one will die. A child will not pay for the sins of the father, and the father will not pay for the sins of the child;

8. turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and keep all my statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die; “For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God”;

9. “Repent, and turn yourselves from all your transgressions; so iniquity shall not be your ruin”;
