Answers:

- 1. a) Belteshazzar b) Shadrach c) Meshach d) Abednego;
- 2. Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank, therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself; God gave all four of them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom, and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams; because Daniel purposed in his heart to please God, not man;
- **3.** Daniel went to his house, and made the thing known to Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, his companions, that they would desire mercies of the God of heaven concerning this secret so that Daniel and his fellows should not perish with the rest of the wise men of Babylon; God in heaven that reveals secrets, and makes known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the latter days;
- **4.** the king said, "Of a truth it is, that your God is a God of gods, and a Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets," the king made Daniel a great man, gave him many great gifts, made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon, chief of the governors over all the wise men of Babylon, and when Daniel requested of the king, he set Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, over the affairs of the province of Babylon;
- 5. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; if ye worship not, ye shall be cast the same hour into the midst of a burning fiery furnace; no; because they would not worship, the king had them thrown the same hour into the midst of a burning fiery furnace;
- **6.** the king saw four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, they have no hurt, and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God; Jesus; the king said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word;
- 7. he lifted his eyes unto heaven, and his mine understanding returned to him, he blessed the most High, he praised and honored God that lives for ever, whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom is from generation to generation. God does according to His will in the army of heaven, and among the inhabitants of the earth, and none can stay his hand, or say unto him, What are you doing? The king's reason returned, along with the glory of his kingdom, he was established in his kingdom, and Nebuchadnezzar praised, extolled, and honored the King of heaven, declaring all His works are truth.
