Notice that we saw: Jesus' Compassion; a Lack of Faith; Little Faith; Faith; Great Faith; and even the rejection of Jesus. In these Miracles of Jesus, there was a call to action – to believe, or not to believe.

Answers:

1. A leper

2. Jesus entered a house, began to preach, and four men brought a man with palsy to be healed. Because there was no room in the house, they uncovered part of the roof and lowered the man down in front of Jesus. When Jesus saw their faith, Jesus said “thy sins be forgiven thee”. When Jesus perceived in his spirit the scribes thoughts, Jesus said, “that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins”. Jesus told him to take his bed and go home. The man obeyed Jesus.

3. A man in the synagogue; because of their hardened hearts, the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against Jesus, how they might destroy Him.

4. Jesus said he had not found so great faith, no, not in Israel

5. When Jesus saw a dead young man being carried out from his widowed mother, Jesus had compassion, and raised the young man from the dead, delivering him back to his mother.

6. When the disciples awakened Jesus who was sleeping on the ship during the terrible storm, they were amazed that He said “Peace, be still” and the storm ceased and there was a great calm. The disciples feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?

7. Jesus healed a woman when she touched His garment from an issue of blood twelve years declaring it was because of her faith, and Jesus raised Jairus’ daughter from the dead

8. “Believe ye that I am able to do this?”; Yes; “According to your faith be it unto you”; Yes; “See that no man know it”; spread abroad his fame in all that country

9. Jesus sent the disciple in the ship while He went up the mount to pray. During a storm, the men saw Jesus walking on the sea, and not knowing it was Jesus, they were afraid. Jesus told them to not fear, and Peter asked Jesus to call him out onto the water. When Jesus said come, Peter walked on the water until he took his eyes off Jesus. He began to sink, and Jesus lifted him out. Jesus said, “O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?” When they were on the ship, the storm ceased. The disciples recognized Jesus was the Son of God.

10. The daughter of a woman of Canaan who was grievously vexed with a devil; she recognized that even though she was a Gentile, Jesus could help her. Because of her great faith, Jesus made her daughter whole.
