Answers:

- 1. Parables:
- 2. A sower sowed seed: some fell by the wayside and fowls devoured it, some fell on stony ground, grew quickly but the sun scorched it and it withered for lack of root, some fell into thorns and choked it so it yielded no fruit, other fell on good ground producing fruit; "He that hath ears to hear, let him hear";
- **3.** Because it was given unto Believers to understand and for others, "because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not, neither do they understand";
- **4.** If they did not understand this simpler parable, how would they be able to understand ones that are more difficult?; God's Word; those who heard God's Word and received it;
- **5.** The Shepherd of the sheep and the Door of the sheep; the sheep know the voice of the true Shepherd and the Door is the only way to enter the sheepfold;
- **6.** "What shall I do to inherit eternal life?"; to do what the Law teaches to do; who is my neighbor?; the Good Samaritan and how he took care of the man that no one else would take care of which revealed that the neighbor was the one that showed mercy on the injured man; the lawyer was to go and do likewise;

- **8.** A proud Pharisee declared how righteous he was in his prayer, while the publican smote his breast asking God to be merciful him because he was a sinner.
