Answers:

1. 3. A woman of Samaria; Messiah which is called Christ; “I that speak unto thee am he”; she went back to town, told all of the men, and they went to see Jesus; many of the Samaritans believed on Jesus for the saying of the woman, He stayed two days and many more believed;
