Answers:

1. Jesus carried his cross to a place called in the Hebrew Golgotha;
2. They compelled Simon a Cyrenian, to bear his cross;
3. Write the verses from your Bible;
4. They crucified Jesus, and parted his garments, casting lots;
5. The rulers derided Jesus saying, He saved others; let him save himself, if he be Christ, the chosen of God; the soldiers;
6. When Jesus cried again with a loud voice, He yielded up the ghost. Then the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom, the earth did quake, the rocks rent, the graves were opened, and many bodies of the saints which slept arose;
7. One of the thieves on the cross; the centurion;
8. When the soldiers saw that Jesus was dead already, they broke not his legs, but with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water;
9. Joseph of Arimathaea, and Nicodemus;
10. The chief priests and Pharisees went to Pilate and asked him to command therefore that the sepulcher be made sure until the third day, lest Jesus' disciples come by night, and steal him away, and say unto the people, He has risen from the dead. Pilate gave them the watch. So they went, and made the sepulcher sure, sealing the stone, and setting a watch;
11. There was a great earthquake, the angel of the Lord descended, and rolled the stone away from the sepulcher, and for fear of him the keepers did shake, and became as dead;
12. The women brought spices they had prepared to the sepulcher, found the stone rolled away, entered and Jesus' body was gone. While they stood confused, two men in shining garments stood by them. The women were afraid, bowed down and the men said, "Why seek ye the living among the dead? He is not here, but is risen." They reminded them of what Jesus had told them, "The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again." And they remembered His words.
