4. Yes; they were all filled with the Holy Ghost; to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance; because there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven and this enabled them to hear the Gospel message in their own language
5. They were pricked in their hearts and asked Peter what they should do; repent and be baptized and they would receive the gift of Holy Ghost for all those who were called by God; about 3000 responded
