Answers:

- 1. The widows were neglected; because the number of the disciples was multiplied; look out among them and find seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom they could appoint over this business;
 - 2. Stephen, Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas;
 - 3. Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people;
- **4.** They stirred up the people, and the elders, and the scribes, and came upon Stephen, and caught him, and brought him to the council, and set up false witnesses;
 - 5. Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, Aaron, Joshua (Jesus), David, Solomon, etc.;
 - **6.** They were cut to the heart, and they gnashed on him with their teeth;
- 7. They cast Stephen out of the city and stoned him; a young man whose name was Saul; Stephen saw the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God;
