Answers:

1. There was a great persecution against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered abroad throughout the regions of Judaea and Samaria;

2. He made havock of the church, entering into every house, and haling men and women committed them to prison;

3. Philip; Christ;

4. He used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one and the people gave him regard saying, “This man is the great power of God”;

5. Simon said he believed also and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done;

6. Peter and John;

7. Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God and to repent of his wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of his heart may be forgiven him;

8. The angel of the Lord told Philip to go toward the south unto the way down from Jerusalem unto Gaza, which is desert;

9. A eunuch of great authority of Ethiopia under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, who had the charge of all her treasure; he had gone to Jerusalem to worship; Philip was to go near, and join himself to his chariot;

10. Philip ran to him, and heard him read the prophet Isaiah and asked if he understood what he read. When the man did not understand, Philip helped him understand by beginning at the same Scripture and preached unto him of Jesus;

11. He said, “I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God”, he commanded the chariot to stand still, they went down into the water, both Philip and the eunuch, and Philip baptized him;

12. The Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, so that the eunuch saw him no more, Philip was found in Azotus, and passing through he preached in all the cities till he came to Caesarea;
