Answers:

1. Threatenings and slaughter against the disciples of the Lord; that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them bound unto Jerusalem;

4. Ananias; go to the street called Straight, and enquire in the house of Judas for one called Saul of Tarsus, put his hand on him so Saul could receive his sight;

Ananias had heard by many of this man and how much evil he had done to the saints at Jerusalem, and Saul had authority to bind any who believed in Jesus; (answers may vary); Yes, Ananias obeyed God; Brother Saul; because Ananias understood God had saved Saul for he was to be filled with the Holy Ghost of God;

6. Immediately there fell from Saul’s eyes as it had been scales, he received his sight, he arose, and was baptized;

7. When he had received meat, he was strengthened and he stayed certain days with the disciples which were at Damascus; Yes; straightway Saul preached in the synagogues that Christ is the Son of God;
