Answers:

**1.** Peter went to the saints that dwelt at Lydda where he found a man named Aeneas, who was sick of the palsy and confined to his bed for eight years. Peter said, “Jesus Christ maketh thee whole: arise, and make thy bed.” He arose immediately; all that dwelt at Lydda and Saron saw him, and turned to the Lord;

**2.** she was sick, died, and they laid her in the upper chamber; Peter prayed, turned to the body and said, “Tabitha, arise.” And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up; many believed in the Lord;

**3.** Cornelius was a centurion of the Italian band; to send men to Joppa, and call for Simon, whose surname is Peter

**4.** Cornelius called two of his household servants, and a devout soldier that waited on him continually, he told them what the Lord had told him and sent them to Joppa;

**5.** Peter went up upon the housetop to pray about the sixth hour; “Behold, three men seek thee. Arise therefore, and get thee down, and go with them, doubting nothing: for I have sent them”; Yes

**6.** Cornelius had called together his kinsmen and near friends, and when Peter came he told Peter, “Now therefore are we all here present before God, to hear all things that are commanded thee of God”;

**7.** God is no respecter of persons and in every nation he that fears Him, and works righteousness, is accepted with Him. (Anyone who believes in Jesus can be saved);

**8.** That on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost;
