Answers:

1. As far as Phenice, and Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the word to the Jews only;
2. When they were come to Antioch, they preached Jesus to the Grecians;
3. The hand of the Lord was with them, a great number believed, and turned to the Lord;
4. Barnabas; to Tarsus; Paul; Antioch;
5. Christians;
6. Herod stretched forth his hands to vex certain of the church; he killed James the brother of John with the sword; this pleased the Jews; he took Peter and put him in prison;
7. They prayed for Peter without ceasing; Peter slept;
8. The angel of the Lord came to Peter, shined a light shined in the prison, smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. Peter's chains fell off from his hands;
9. Peter put on his coat and shoes and followed the angel; Peter didn't believe what was happening, but thought he was seeing a vision; the gate swung open of its own accord;
10. Peter understood that the Lord sent his angel, and delivered him out of the hand of Herod;
11. To the house of Mary the mother of John; many were gathered together praying;
12. Rhoda; they said she was mad (crazy); they were astonished;
12. It is the voice of a god, and not of a man; immediately the angel of the Lord smote him, because he gave not God the glory: and he was eaten of worms, and gave up the ghost (he died);
