Answers:

1. For a man that knows the law, the law hath dominion over him as long as he lives; having been delivered from the law, we should serve in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter;

2. Yes, for the Law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good;

3. Answers may vary, but most likely the answer is yes; the law is spiritual, but I am carnal. What I would, that do I not, but what I hate is often what I do. However it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwells in me, so when I would do good, evil is present with me. For a Christian living in this world, it will be a constant struggle to choose to good over evil.

4. Christians are to walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit, knowing that they that are in the flesh cannot please God;

5. That Israel might be saved; to see others saved; Share the Word of faith in Jesus, help them understand: “9. That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 13. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved”

6. Christians are to be living sacrifices before God (living a life pleasing to God), and be not conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of one’s mind which enables one to know God’s will and then to do it;

7. To be subject unto the higher powers, knowing that God placed them there, and to not resist them, for then one will be resisting God;

8. Owe no man any thing, but to love one another, obey God’s commands, cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light, understanding that time is short, “13. Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying”, “put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ” and do not fulfill the lusts of the flesh;

9. “So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God”;
