Answers:

1. From Jesus Christ; sent to John;
2. “he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein”;
3. It was directed initially to the churches in Asia, however, these words are also directed to what is referred to as “the seven church ages” which are understood to have taken place throughout history;
4. To repent and “... if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me”
5. The voice he heard sounded like a trumpet that said “Come up hither, and I will shew thee things; the rapture;
6. The Great Tribulation;
7. The Devil was cast out of heaven; one-third of the angels – those who had fought with him;
8. From heaven’s perspective;
9. Every man (who had not already been resurrected) will be judged according to his works;
